### HELP FIGHT HUNGER DURING LENT

One in 17 Minnesotans rely upon local food shelves to help feed their families. Last year, there were 2 million visits and 47 million pounds of food distributed at Minnesota's 300 food shelves. Each March, Minnesota FoodShare runs the largest food drive in the state and restocks food shelves across Minnesota. Each Weekend during Lent OLP will be collecting food for the Minnehaha Food Shelf. Each week we will announce from the pulpit and bulletin the items we will be collecting for the following Sunday, so watch the bulletin each week. Next weekend, March 7-8) we will be collecting diapers and baby wipes. Please place your donations in the boxes at the entrances to the Church. Monetary donations are also accepted. Please bring your monetary donations to the parish office by March 30th or deposit them in the collection clearly indicating that they are for the food shelf.
