WORSHIP MINISTRY

Altar Servers • Calling all 5th grade Students and Parents

All students in Grade 5 and up are invited to become altar servers for our parish.

Each server will be scheduled to serve at a particular Mass (5 pm, 9 am, or 11 am) every month or so. It will be your responsibility as parents to see that he/she is there for each scheduled liturgy, at least 15 minutes early, and to offer encouragement and support - in particular, by your regular attendance at Sunday worship.

There is a training period, consisting of two practices. The practices will be held in the church, and will last one hour. It is necessary that the new server be at one practice session each week.

HABITAT FOR HUMANITY

How it works. Using volunteer labor and tax-deductible donations HFH builds and rehabilitates houses with the help of future homeowners (partner families). Houses are sold to partner families at no profit, financed through affordable, no-interest 20 year mortgages. Monthly mortgage payments are used to support the construction of more houses.

This year Our Lady of Peace will partner with Diamond Lake, Lake Nokomis, Nokomis Heights, Bethel and Hope Lutheran Churches and a family to build a home for that family. **Our work weeks are July 27 through August 7.**
