Anticipating a Baptism within the next three to four months??

The following is important information as you begin to plan.

- To schedule a baptism contact Joy Biedrzycki either by phone or email.
- You will receive a letter with needed info and a keepsake booklet for you to read.
- About the preparation sessions:
 - If you are new to Our Lady of Peace or if this is the first child you are having baptized here, we ask that you participate in two sessions. The first session is facilitated by a member of our parish staff. The session date for this quarter is September 15h 6:30pm in the Whalen Room.
 - The second session is held right before your baptism date. This session will happen in the home of one of our preparation couples. You will be contacted about the day and time and place.
 - If you have already had a child baptized here at Our Lady of Peace, you need not come to the first session but are invited to the second session. Again, this is held in the home of one of our preparation couples and you will be contacted about the day and time and place.
