Every parish thrives by the generosity of people sharing their time, talent and treasure. At Our Lady of Peace, we can be very grateful for the commitment so many have made in the past and continue to make which helps build our community and helps us be a strong presence in South Minneapolis. An important responsibility of the staff and the leadership councils of the parish is be good stewards of the contributions people make to this parish.

While the stewardship of time, talent and treasure are intricately linked, now is our time to focus on treasure – or the financial aspect of stewardship. These past couple of years, we have been especially attentive to seeing how we can reduce our expenses and we have made real progress. We are reducing our debt through the Securing Foundations Campaign, we are finding ways to save money on utilities and regular operating expenses, and we have been forced to stretch an already hardworking staff by eliminating some positions and holding salaries flat for the last several years. While we will continue to look for ways to reduce expenses, we have to turn our attention to increasing revenue so we can continue to close the gap in our budget deficit and also handle any increases in the expenses which continue to rise.

This past week, parishioner received a letter notifying them that we are beginning the 2009 Offertory Appeal. Since we rely mainly on what we regularly receive in the regular stewardship and Sunday giving, our appeal is very focused with several objectives: 1) to encourage all parishioners to make regular contributions through the envelope system or through automatic withdrawal; 2) to introduce and reaffirm the concepts of Christian stewardship; and 3) to request a slight increase in the offering by all members of the parish.

In the next several weeks, you will receive more information about our appeal with specific requests on how you can help. We hope that everyone will prayerfully consider a modest financial increase and respond in the next week or two. 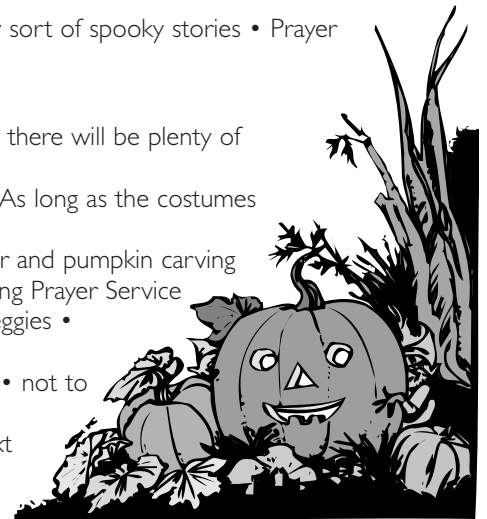
